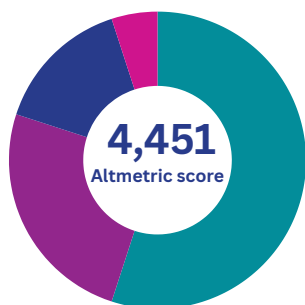

Top 5% of all research outputs ever tracked by Altmetric

The team's Lancet paper (May 2026) recorded an Altmetric Score of 4,451 (August 2026) — among the highest ever recorded for a health policy publication, and placing it in the top 5% of more than 25 million outputs Altmetric has tracked. The score reflects extraordinary reach across international news media, social media, policy documents, and public discussion of a research output that began in academia and reached patients, clinicians and policymakers worldwide.

REACH & ENGAGEMENT

- **2 Billion** people reached across international news media (Monash University Report, July 2026)

POLICY & RESEARCH TRANSLATION

- Formal **WHO ICD-11 reclassification** proposal submitted June 2026, targeting the WHO Annual Meeting, October 2026.
- Adopted into the **International Evidence-Based Guideline**, used in 195 countries, with full terminology update in 2028.
- Companion publications in **Nature Medicine** and **BMJ**; manuscripts invited by **NEJM** and **JAMA**
- **Pharmaceutical update** underway
- **Global curriculum update** underway across 400 universities worldwide

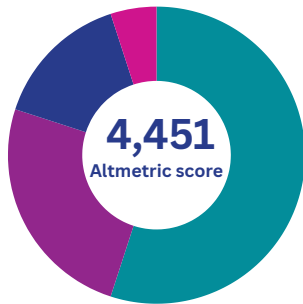
